## The Key 3 duties of network are:

...mending, tending, and extending the nets in the name of Christ. This means we:

1. work toward reconciliation and healing in relationships (mending);

2. look for productive and peaceful and win-win ways, not destructive ways to manage differences in relationships (tending), and

3. are always reaching to connect with people who are yearning for connection (extending).
